Employer Support for the Guard and Reserve

Chairman Carl Lambert enlisted in the Indiana Army National Guard in September 1965, transferring in 1967 to the Illinois Army National Guard. During his tenure in Illinois, he attained the rank of Staff Sergeant (E-6) and he became a full-time employee of the IL Army National Guard. In 1972, he transferred to the US Army Reserve in Southern Indiana/Louisville, KY area. He was employed with various USAR units in this area, attaining the military rank of Chief Warrant Officer Two (CW2) during this time, until being offered a position with a newly activated General Officer Command in Nashville, TN. There he became the Logistics Management Specialist in the G-4. This led to the position of Supervisory Logistics Management Specialist and eventually the position of Supervisory Staff Administrator, the senior civilian technician in the unit. CW4 Lambert retired in 2006.



Having been affiliated with ESGR for many years, Mr. Lambert has become much more active since retiring. He accepted the position of Middle Tennessee Area Chairman in December 2007. In December 2008, he was appointed a member of the Volunteer Awards and Recognition Subcommittee, later named the Volunteer Management Subcommittee, representing the Southeast Region. In January 2011, he accepted the position of Acting State Chairman for the Tennessee ESGR Committee and was officially installed as the Tennessee State Chairman in September 2011.
